TETRAPLOID

Being a tetraploid, **ABUNDANT** has larger leaves, higher water content, and is more palatable than many diploid varieties. **ABUNDANT** will produce high quality feed for use as pasture, hay or silage. Another advantage of **ABUNDANT** is that it was bred for vigor, disease resistance and high performance. **ABUNDANT** has high levels of resistance to the major diseases affecting forage ryegrasses, including: crown and leaf rust, leaf spot and scald, powdery mildew and pythium blight.
