## QUICK FACTS

EARLY HEADING TETRAPLOID

**TETRAMAX** is one of our earliest heading Perennial Ryegrass varieties. Results from Penn State trials indicate that **TETRAMAX** is a good forage yielder with an even yield distribution throughout the growing season. One important feature of **TETRAMAX** is that it starts growing early in the spring compared to other varieties, which allows for earlier grazing. As with other tetraploid varieties, **TETRAMAX** has higher palatability when compared to diploid varieties.
